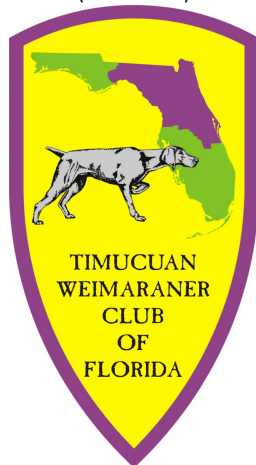

Attention Exhibitors

Grooming Building will be open Thursday from 5-7 pm for Specialty groups ONLY.

Gates open Friday 6:30 a.m.

Grooming will be in the Townsend Building and is air-conditioned. All dogs must be removed from the grooming area immediately after Best in Show judging each day. The building will be locked, and there will be no access to the grooming area.

Loading and Unloading: There will be a 15-minute loading and unloading time for vehicles. The club will require that you leave your vehicle running, lights on & unlocked. If the 15-minute time limit is not observed, the vehicle owner risks the vehicle being moved by a club representative or towing. This is necessary for complying with Fire Marshall regulations. **No soft sided** crates in any building. All chairs must be removed from the ring areas immediately following judging. Any chairs left in the buildings will be removed.

No dogs allowed in restrooms.

Full hookups are available. Check with West Volusia Kennel Club for RV reservations.

Parking - All car & van parking \$5.00; a three-day parking pass is \$12.00. Anyone leaving their vehicle overnight in a non-hookup area will be charged a \$20.00 fee.

Full hookups or dry hookups please pay by check or money orders only! Payable to West Volusia Kennel Club Inc. No advance payment.

Entry fee shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred. Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds.

Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of the entry without the Agreement and Rules from the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

No entry shall be made or accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Errors on Entry Blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to the close of entries, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 5 of the Dog Show Rules. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

A recording fee of 50 cents and an event fee of \$1.50 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club, Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. This fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fee is collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2)

All dogs must be held on leash except when in the exercise area or crated.

Judging schedule and map to the show site will be mailed as soon as possible after the closing of entries.

Grooming will be conducted in the designated grooming room(s) only, no grooming ringside. Please clean up after yourself and your dog.

All crates must be stacked in the grooming area.

Exercise pens will be permitted in designated areas only.

Dogs entered at this show MUST have up to date rabies and shot records available.

No space for unentered dogs.

COVID-19 Guidelines

·Please wear a mask when in close contact with others & in any of the buildings. When you are gaiting your dog, you may drop your mask but as soon as you're done gaiting, put your mask back up.

·There is no ringside seating, however, exhibitors can bring their own chairs, but must maintain social distancing between each other & from the rings. Household units are free to sit together. No group gatherings or congregating in the buildings.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. - (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in., but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
